Surgeoner to Address Ridgetown Campus Graduates

The 56th Annual Spring Convocation at Ridgetown Campus will be held on Friday, May 30th. Over 700 guests are expected to help celebrate the achievements of 165 graduates from the diploma and certificate programs in Agriculture, Horticulture, Environmental Management, Veterinary Technology and Veterinary Medical Office Administration.

"We are very proud of the achievements of the Class of 2008; many of them have already demonstrated their leadership abilities on campus and I know they will be great leaders in their chosen careers," says Campus Director, Dr. Art Schaafsma.

The ceremony will begin at 2:00 p.m. in the Rudy H. Brown Rural Development Centre. The Class of 2008 has selected Nicole Ruest, Agriculture Diploma student from Palmerston, ON. to deliver the valedictory address.
